SKULL CANDY

Metamorphosing parabolas of paint, distorted comb shapes, mentholated crystal formations, curtain configurations composed in drips, briny pools of evaporated pigment, and cotton-candy-colored washes multiply in Jackie Saccoccio's radiant new paintings. Each canvas comprises controlled moments of chaos and cacophony that congeal into enclosed rectangular forms that evoke heads. These being-things, hung in cheek-to-jowl portrait-gallery fashion, connect to Peloponnesian helmets, Song-dynasty glazing, and a symphony of associations played out in parallax flashes of abstraction, evocation, attitude, space, and paint.
