## "<u>Richard Diebenkorn</u>: Works on Paper, 1955-1967" <u>Van Doren Waxter</u> – New York November 8 – January 20

Organized in partnership with the Richard Diebenkorn Foundation, this show examines the formative years the pioneering American abstract artist spent in the Bay Area, melding elements of abstraction and figuration in a way that was considered sacrilegious by the avant-garde's purists at the time.
